## Summary of UW-Madison Polling Places for Election Day April 2, 2019

### **Polling places serving UW residence halls**

**Smith Hall**, ward 54, 35 N. Park St. Ogg and Smith Halls (1119 residents).

**Porchlight**, ward 55, 306 N. Brooks St. just south of University Ave. Merit Hall, Susan B. Davis Hall, and Zoe Bayliss Co-op.

**Gordon Dining**, ward 56, 770 W. Dayton. Witte and Sellery Halls (2266 residents) (and Lucky Apartments).

**Memorial Union**, ward 58, 800 Langdon St. Barnard and Chadbourne Halls (719 residents). Also Lakeshore Halls east of Babcock Drive (Adams, Elizabeth Waters, Slichter, and Tripp, 1188 residents). 1907 residents total.

**Holt Center**, ward 59, 1650 Kronshage. Lakeshore Halls west of Babcock Drive (Bradley, Cole, Dejope, Kronshage, Leopold, Phillips, and Sullivan). 2104 residents.

### **Other on-campus polling places:**

Ward 57 votes at UW Memorial library, 728 State St. Alder district 8.

Ward 60 votes at Eagle Heights Community Center, 611 Eagle Hts.

Wards 47 and 48 vote at Lowell Center, 610 Langdon St.

Union South is not a polling place, but has a student voter ID printer.
